Trip Cost: \$3,638 (approximate – not including airfare) Note: This trip is limited to just 17 participants

The above prices are based on <u>Double Occupancy</u> & the following:

- \$3,238 for Land Expense
- \$400 donation to Devar Emet for Rabbi Kirk Gliebe's trip expenses & to support the work of the Outreach
- \$1,200 round trip ticket out of Chicago (approximate and not included in the listed price)

Registration for the trip requires a \$500 deposit. The first payment of \$1,500 is due by September 1. The final balance for the trip is due by November 1.

Payments should be made on the payment schedule for this tour. Failure to make payments on the payment schedule, may result in your loss of place on the tour with cancellation fees. Payments need to be made by check or through Chase QuickPay (Devar Emet \ info@devaremet.org). All payments need to clearly state the name of the individual(s) the money is for.

Prices are based on existing U.S. dollar exchange rate, current costs, fuel charges, and tariff rates, and are subject to change (beyond our control) based on the dollar and international market. Should prices change, you will be notified immediately, and you will be responsible to pay any additional costs.

Price Includes:

- LODGING Double Occupancy = 2 people per room
- SINGLE ROOM If do not want a roommate, the additional cost of a single room is \$900.00. If you want a roommate, but do not have a roommate, we will try to place you with another single traveler of the same gender. However, if no one is available to room with you, you will be charged for a single room. If you are traveling with (or have been assigned) a roommate who cancels, you will be responsible for a single room if no one else is available to be your roommate.
- MEALS breakfast and dinner daily with coffee and tea except for dinner on the final day. Two lunches will also be provided.
- TOURING per itinerary, (subject to adjustment) with licensed Israeli Tour Guide in private air-conditioned tour bus with Israeli driver.
- ALL TIPS and FEES (for tour guide, driver, porters, dining & hotel staff), taxes, entrance fees, transportation costs.

Price Does Not Include

Most lunches, beverages (other than coffee and tea), personal expenses (snacks, phone, laundry, internet), travel/trip insurance.

Refunds/Cancellations

All cancellation notices must be received in writing (letter or e-mail) to Devar Emet's office. Refunds for cancellation are based on the cancellation schedule below:

Prior to 42 days	Deposit only
41-29 days	45%
28-15 days	60%
14 days or less	100% of Trip Cost

If there would ever be a serious security situation or war, where the traveler's government would issue an advisory against all but essential travel to Israel, Devar Emet would refund the full cost of the tour minus a US\$300 per person administration fee.

Passport

- You are responsible for the accuracy of your Passport information.
- You must have a valid passport with an expiration date 6 months after the date of our return to the U.S. If you need a new or renewed passport, it takes several weeks to secure one, so don't delay applying/updating.

Inoculations & Visas

At this time, no inoculations or visas (for U.S. Citizens) are required for Israel.

Luggage

One piece of checked luggage, maximum 50 pounds. Plus, one small personal bag (small enough to comfortably fit on your lap on the tour bus, e.g. a back-pack). Luggage is limited due to the tour bus luggage bay capacity.

Trip/Travel Insurance:

Shoresh Tours (handling the Land travel in Israel for Devar Emet) REQUIRES Travel Insurance. This type of insurance will cover the cost of your trip should you need to cancel because of an emergency prior to departure, or return mid-trip to the States because of an emergency, illness or injury. It will also provide financial coverage for medical or personal emergencies while you are in Israel. Please secure the insurance plan of your choice immediately upon registering for a trip and carry the information with you as you travel.

Physical Requirements & Responsibility

Devar Emet's *Adult Israel Aliyah* is not a looking-out-the-bus-window-experience. Our tours are a feet-on-the-ground adventure that requires travelers to be in generally good health, be able and willing to see sights from about 7:30am to 5:30pm each day, and are responsible to have independent mobility and strength. There is significant amounts of walking (15,000 steps a day on average) over uneven archaeological terrain and nature pathways as well as up hills and ancient stairs. To participate in this tour successfully, you need to be able to climb flights of stairs without assistance and walk at a modest pace for at least a mile, as well as be able to stand in possibly hot weather.

Individuals registering for this journey accept the **responsibility for being in good health and able to walk without assistance**. If you require a cane, crutches, wheelchair or personal assistance to walk, sorry but this is not the trip for you. You must be physically able to independently walk and travel with the tour group.
